Elain Elizabeth Hazle was born April 2, 1974 at Community Hospital in Montclair, NJ. She was the first daughter of Dorrel and Beryl Hazle and the second of three children.

On February 5, 1989 at 15 years of age, she symbolized her dedication to Jehovahah by water baptism. Thus would begin her lifetime as a minister of Jehovah's Witnesses.

Elain attended Montclair High School and proudly graduated with the Class of 1992. The summer of graduation, she moved to Redmond, Washington to live with her older brother.
